

Job Description

Position: Lifeguard

General Summary: Supervision patrons and enforce safety rules of the Municipal Swimming Pool

Essential Functions:

1. Monitor all swimming pool patrons in and out of water
2. Enforce all safety rules and regulations of the Municipal Swimming Pool
3. Document and record all major patron disciplinary problems
4. Provide primary first aid to Municipal Swimming Pool patrons
5. Prepare all necessary documents and reports relating accidents
6. Perform daily maintenance of facilities including guard room, bathrooms and deck
7. Teach assigned swim classes
8. Public relations
9. Other duties as assigned by the Manager and Assistant Manager

Knowledge and Skills:

1. Able to lift 50lbs
2. Able to use various tools for maintenance of facilities
3. Able to climb ladders
4. Able to stand or sit for extended periods of time
5. Able to communicate knowledge of operations, skills, and training to personnel and students of various ages

Entry Level Requirements:

1. Current American Red Cross Lifeguard Training certificate
2. Water Safety Training not required, but preferred.
3. First aid and CPR certified

Working Conditions:

1. Report to Pool Manager, or Assistant Pool Manager in Manager's absence
2. Normal work hours will require morning, afternoon, evening, and weekend shifts
3. Position is seasonal
4. Performance of duties will require frequent and extensive outdoor exposure both in and out of pool water
5. Vigorous athletic activity
6. Possible exposure to hazardous and dangerous chemicals
