

**MINUTES OF THE NOVEMBER 2, 2020 MEETING  
OF THE HUMBOLDT CITY COUNCIL**

The Humboldt City Council met in regular session on Monday, November 2, 2020 in the Council Chambers of the Humboldt Municipal Building. Mayor Daniel Scholl called the meeting to order at 5:30 PM. Council Members present: Goodell, Sleiter, Dominick, Worthington, and Whittlesey.

Motion by Goodell, Second by Worthington to approve the following Consent Agenda items: 1) the agenda as printed; 2) the minutes of the October 19, 2020 regular Council meeting; and 3) the October Investment Report; 4) the October claims; and 5) the renewal of a Class E Liquor License, Class B Native Wine Permit, Class C Beer Permit, and Sunday Sales Privilege for Kimmes Enterprises LLC d/b/a Kimmes Humboldt Country Store #14. (5) Ayes, motion carried.

Public Input comments were made by Steve Reedy regarding the cleanup of the property at 901 Taft Street N after the controlled burn conducted there.

Motion by Goodell, Second by Worthington to approve the following proposed Resolution No. 2020-123: “A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FIRE PROTECTION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF HUMBOLDT, IOWA AND THE CITY OF RUTLAND EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2019 UNTIL MIDNIGHT JUNE 30, 2022.”

Roll Call Vote: Ayes – Goodell, Sleiter, Dominick, Worthington, and Whittlesey. Motion carried.

Motion by Worthington, Second by Whittlesey to approve the following proposed Resolution No. 2020-124: “A RESOLUTION APPROVING A CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT REHABILITATION MATCHING GRANT AWARD AND DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO MAKE PAYMENT AS ESTABLISHED IN THE PROGRAM SUMMARY TO SISTER’S HOME STYLE ENTREES.”

Roll Call Vote: Ayes – Sleiter, Dominick, Worthington, Whittlesey, and Goodell. Motion carried.

Motion by Goodell, Second by Whittlesey to approve the following proposed Resolution No. 2020-125: “A RESOLUTION APPROVING PAY ESTIMATE NO. 3 WITH SANDE CONSTRUCTION OF HUMBOLDT, IOWA IN THE AMOUNT OF \$39,783.52 FOR THE 10<sup>TH</sup> STREET NORTH/12<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE NORTH STREET RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT.”

Roll Call Vote: Ayes – Dominick, Worthington, Whittlesey, Goodell, and Sleiter. Motion carried.

Motion by Goodell, Second by Worthington to approve the following proposed Resolution No. 2020-126: “A RESOLUTION APPROVING PAY ESTIMATE NO. 3 WITH BLACKTOP SERVICE COMPANY OF HUMBOLDT, IOWA FOR THE 2020 ROADWAY SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$918,421.38.”

Roll Call Vote: Ayes – Worthington, Whittlesey, Goodell, Sleiter, and Dominick. Motion carried.

Other Items Discussed: City Administrator – Reminded residents not to dump hot ashes at the compost site. He also announced that the stop signs at the Wildcat Road and Highway 169 intersection will be replaced with signs outlined with flashing lights. He expressed his thanks to State Senator Kraayenbrink for his assistance in getting the DOT approval for that change. City

Clerk – Reminded the Council of the open burning dates and stated that the polling place for those who normally vote at City Hall will be changed to the Humboldt Community Center for the general election. Whittlesey – Asked when the winter parking regulations would go into effect – December 1<sup>st</sup>.

Motion by Worthington, Second by Goodell to schedule Monday, November 16, 2020 at 5:30 PM as the date and time for the next regular meeting of the Humboldt City Council and to adjourn this session at 5:58 PM. (5) Ayes, motion carried.
