

**MINUTES OF THE APRIL 1, 2024
SPECIAL SESSION OF THE HUMBOLDT CITY COUNCIL**

The Humboldt City Council met in special session on Monday, April 1, 2024. Mayor Daniel Scholl called the meeting to order at 5:15 PM. Council Members present: Goodell, Sleiter, Dominick, and Whittlesey. Absent: Harklau.

This being the time and place for the scheduled public hearing on the Proposed Property Tax Levy for the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 City of Humboldt Budget, Mayor Scholl opened the public hearing at 5:16 PM.

The City Administrator reviewed the proposed FY 2024-2025 Proposed Property Tax Levy, noting that the City's total levy for the coming fiscal year of \$16.1519 represents an increase of about thirteen cents from last year's levy. The increase can be attributed to increase in employment costs for additional employees, labor costs, health/property insurance, costs of equipment, materials, and operations. The City of Humboldt levy represents approximately 42.6% of the total property tax levy for Humboldt residents (Humboldt County's levy is 16.25%; the Humboldt Community School District levy is 32.74%).

No written comments or objections on the Proposed Property Tax Levy for the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 were received. There being no comment or objections from the general public, Mayor Scholl closed the public hearing at 5:24 PM.

Motion by Dominick, Second by Whittlesey to adjourn this session at 5:25 PM. (4) Ayes, motion carried.
