

MINUTES OF THE MAY 2, 2022 MEETING OF THE HUMBOLDT CITY COUNCIL

The Humboldt City Council met in regular session on Monday, May 2, 2022 in the Council Chambers of the Humboldt Municipal Building. Mayor Daniel Scholl called the meeting to order at 5:30 PM. Council Members present: Goodell, Dominick, Worthington, and Whittlesey. Absent: Sleiter.

Motion by Goodell, Second by Dominick to approve the following Consent Agenda items: 1) the agenda as printed; 2) the minutes of the April 18, 2022 regular Council meeting; 3) the April Investment Report; 4) the April claims; 5) the renewal of a Special Class C Liquor License, a Class B Wine Permit, and Sunday Sales Privilege for Cottonwood Trails, LLC, d/b/a AmericInn Humboldt (pending dram shop certification); 6) the renewal of a Class E Liquor License, Class B Wine Permit, Class C Beer Permit (Carryout Beer), and Sunday Sales privilege for Casey's Marketing, d/b/a Casey's General Store #51; and 7) the renewal of a Class E Liquor License, a Class C Beer Permit, a Class B Wine Permit, and Sunday Sales Privilege for Hy-Vee, Inc., d/b/a Hy-Vee Wine & Spirits. (4) Ayes, motion carried.

Motion by Worthington, Second by Whittlesey to approve a request from Brian Bidleman and the Christian Motorcyclists Association (CMA) for a street closure and waiver of vendor fees on Sumner Avenue for the Heartland Rally event on July 29, 2022. (4) Ayes, motion carried.

Motion by Dominick, Second by Goodell to approve the following proposed Resolution No. 2022-27: "A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022 BUDGET AMENDMENT ESTIMATE, DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO PUBLISH THE NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND SETTING MONDAY, MAY 16, 2022 AT 5:30 PM AS THE DATE AND TIME FOR A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022 BUDGET AMENDMENT."

Roll Call Vote: Ayes – Goodell, Dominick, Worthington, and Whittlesey. Motion carried.

Motion by Whittlesey, Second by Worthington to approve the following proposed Resolution No. 2022-28: "A RESOLUTION SETTING 5:30 PM ON MONDAY, MAY 16, 2022 AS THE TIME AND DATE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER THE DISPOSITION BY SALE OF PUBLIC PROPERTY."

Roll Call Vote: Ayes – Dominick, Worthington, Whittlesey, and Goodell. Motion carried.

Motion by Worthington, Second by Dominick to approve the following proposed Resolution No. 2022-29: "A RESOLUTION APPOINTING CITY OFFICIALS AND REPRESENTATIVES TO VARIOUS CITY BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS."

Roll Call Vote: Ayes – Worthington, Whittlesey, Goodell, and Dominick. Motion carried.

Motion by Goodell, Second by Worthington, to approve the following proposed Resolution No. 2022-30: "A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT AND ACCOMPANYING LETTERS OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF HUMBOLDT, IOWA AND THE CHAUFFEURS, TEAMSTERS AND HELPERS LOCAL UNION NO. 238 FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE HUMBOLDT POLICE DEPARTMENT FROM JULY 1, 2022 TO JUNE 30, 2023."

Roll Call Vote: Ayes – Whittlesey, Goodell, Dominick, and Worthington. Motion carried.

Other Items Discussed: City Administrator – Reviewed the City Administrator’s council report. Deputy City Clerk – Announced that Sumner Avenue street poles have been set and the signs should be placed this week. A citizen inquired about permits for electric scooters. Worthington – Wanted the template for the grant proposal for the Wildcat Wonderland project. Whittlesey – talked about the Soyland project. Goodell – discussed the traffic study on Highway 3. Dominick – Discussed the vandalism that had happened during the weekend at the recycling center.

Motion by Worthington, Second by Whittlesey, to schedule Monday, May 16, 2022 at 5:30 PM as the date and time for the next regular meeting of the Humboldt City Council and adjourn this session at 5:55 PM. (4) Ayes, motion carried.
